This plan is to prepare you to function safely and efficiently, to the extent possible, should an emergency disrupt normal operations.

Association Emergency Spokesperson

In the event of a crisis during the Annual Meeting, the President/CEO Lynn M. Gangone will serve as the designated spokesperson. If this is not possible, Board Chair Kim Metcalf will fill this role. If both are unavailable, Vice President Matthew Wales will serve as spokesperson.

The following procedures and telephone numbers are recommended in case of an emergency:

Nearest Pharmacy

Venue Emergency Plan

Please evacuate the building if the alarm goes off and the announcement says to evacuate.

For an outside evacuation, the designated area for safe assembly is 201 Courtland Street (this is an uncovered parking lot).

For an inside evacuation, the designated area for safe assembly is the Hilton Hotel (located on the other side of Courtland Street).

For safety reasons, everyone must remain outside the building until the “All Clear” has been given.

First Aid/CPR

Safety and Loss Prevention Officers are available. These individuals are trained in CPR and First Aid practices, and may act as first responders to medical emergencies.

Security

The Atlanta Marriott Marquis Loss Prevention team patrols the sleeping room corridors 4 times in an 8 hour period. Report suspicious behavior or activities to the appropriate venue utilizing the above-listed contact information. If you “See Something, Say Something.”

Active Shooter

Active shooter situations are unpredictable and evolve quickly. Remain calm. Be aware of your environment and escape routes, and get away from the location of the active shooter as quickly as possible. If possible, help lead others to safety, but take action immediately. Your three best options recommended by Homeland Security are: RUN, HIDE, FIGHT.
